

Correction to “Tramadol Metabolism to O-Desmethyl Tramadol (M1) and N-Desmethyl Tramadol (M2) by Dog Liver Microsomes: Species Comparison and Identification of Responsible Canine Cytochrome P450s”

In the above article [Perez Jimenez TE, Mealey KL, Grubb TL, Greene SA, Court MH (2016) *Drug Metab Dispos* **44**:1963–1972 DOI: <https://doi.org/10.1124/dmd.116.071902>], the unit of measure at the top of the third, fourth, sixth and eighth columns in Table 1 were incorrectly provided as *nmol/min per mg of protein* for columns third and sixth and *ml/min per mg protein* for columns fourth and eighth.

The correct unit of measurement in Table 1 for columns third and sixth is *pmol/min per mg protein* and for columns fourth and eighth is *ml/min per g protein*.
