

## Notice of Change in Page Charge Policy

At the present time, authors of publications in the original research journals of the American Society for Pharmacology and Experimental Therapeutics (ASPET) are assessed a charge of **\$30 per printed page** to help offset costs of publication. The Board of Publications Trustees is pleased to announce that as of **July 1, 1996**, page charges for **Regular** and **Retired** members of ASPET will be reduced to **\$15 per page**; nonmembers continue to pay \$30 per page. **Page charges are not waived.**

The reduced page charge policy is just one of many benefits to membership in ASPET. For nonmembers who may wish to join the Society, a membership application form follows.
