

**CORRECTION TO “A COMBINED MODEL FOR PREDICTING  
CYP3A4 CLINICAL NET DRUG-DRUG INTERACTION BASED ON  
CYP3A4 INHIBITION, INACTIVATION, AND INDUCTION  
DETERMINED IN VITRO”**

In the article referenced above [Fahmi OA, Maurer TS, Kish M, Cardenas E, Boldt S, Nettleton D (2008) *Drug Metab Dispos* **36**:1698–1708], there is an error in the second column, first paragraph of page 1704. The sentence beginning “Thirteen drugs . . .” should read: “Twelve drugs, namely, troleandomycin, ethinyl estradiol, fluoxetine, mibefradil, pioglitazone, rosiglitazone, troglitazone, saquinavir, nelfinavir, ritonavir, mibefradil, and verapamil, were positives in all three in vitro assays.”
